

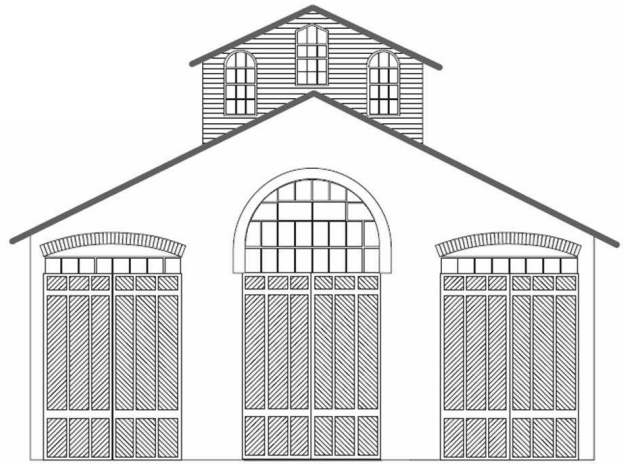

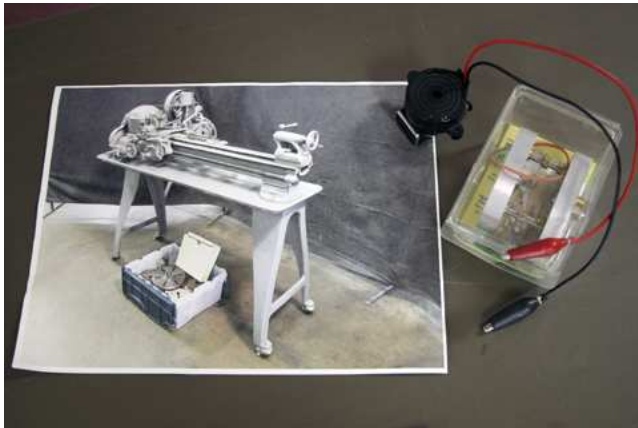
**Dave Thornton** offered a 6 inch dial caliper as his favorite tool.



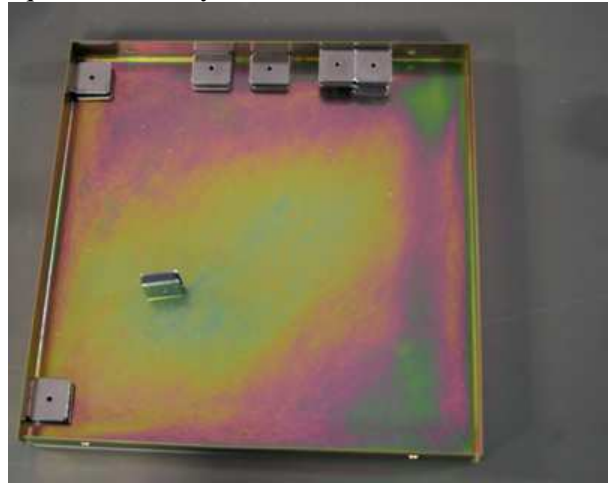
**Richard Kubeck** brought in an RRamp meter and thermos reader.

**Terry Bossick** brought in favorite projects:

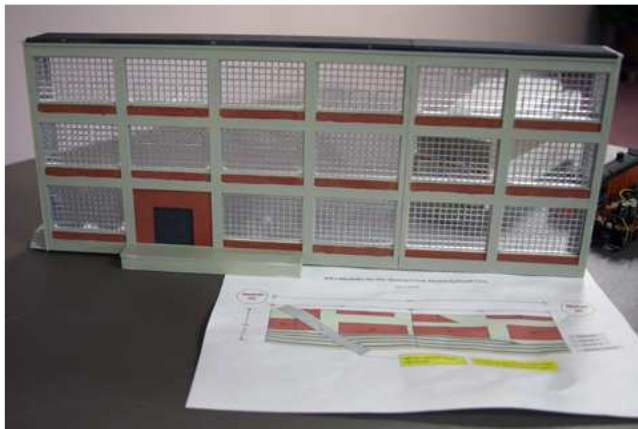
1. Johnstown 2-truck Birney

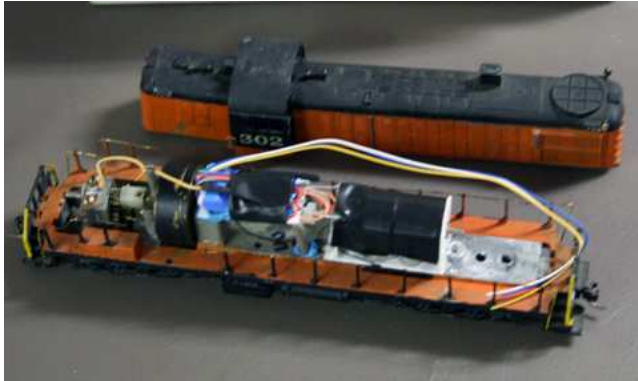

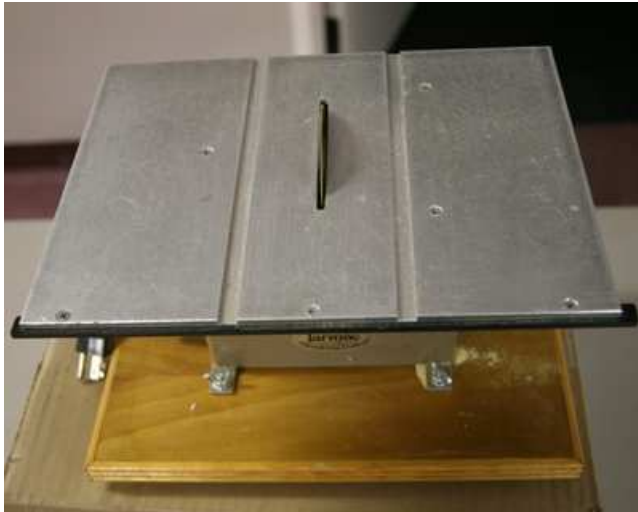
**Ken Scherer** offered an HO scale Hobbytown RS-3 which he added a new can motor and DCC decoder.
